



## **EFF SENDS ITS HEARTFELT CONDOLENCES ON THE COLD MURDER OF MLUNGISI MADONSELA**

The Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF) sends heartfelt condolences to the Madonsela Family after the passing of the young Lion and future leader of our nation, Mlungisi Madonsela.

It is tragic that 25 years into democracy, the black government is still exhibiting the same murderous tendencies of the white oppressive apartheid government. Even more tragic, is that, in a so-called democratic nation, young people are brutally murdered and criminalised in their pursuit for Free Education and yet this was a promise made by the government.

Mlungisi Madonsela was murdered for protesting for free education, in DUT. Just last year, at the Tshwane University of Technology (TUT) a law student, Katlego Monareng was also murdered during a protest outside the university's Soshanguve North Campus. Two young, bright, black students that were fighting to undo the unjust system which excludes the poor from the opportunity to better their lives through education.

The shooting at DUT was uncalled for; and is a clear statement that the government deems black, poor students as the enemies of the state and targets of the South African Police and Campus Security.

We are comforted by the words of Solomon Mahlangu when facing his own death: "Tell my people that I love them and that they must continue the fight, my blood will nourish the tree that will bear the fruits of freedom, Aluta continua."

Rest in peace Young Lion, we will not stop until justice is served and your memory is honoured through free education for all.
