



EFF WELCOMES PROGRESS MADE IN TSHEGOFATSO PULE'S MURDER CASE

The EFF welcomes the successful conviction of Tshegofatso Pule's murderer. Today, the accused pleaded guilty to murdering Tshegofatso Pule and is cooperating with police to arrest his co-conspirators.

We commend the investigation team of the SAPS that managed to bring the accused to justice in less than a year after the crime was committed. This form of dedication and efficiency must be extended to all cases of GBV, even if they do not enjoy a large public profile.

The EFF will continue to monitor this case as a second arrest has been made. This demonstrates that the murderer was not alone and in fact conspired with someone very intimate to the deceased, Tshegofatso Pule.

The Pule family deserves to know the full truth of the brutal murder of their daughter. Tshegofatso was murdered, whilst she was 8 months pregnant and hang on a tree; some display by what seems like the work of a psychopathological killer.

The man will go behind bars. He does not have to murder anyone else's daughter anywhere again. Those who conspired with him must also go behind bars.

This single case demonstrated that justice is possible when the SAPS do their job. It will go a long way to inspire confidence in a country at the brink of despondency when it comes to GBV.
