The EFF is saddened and concerned about the recent news of the disappearance of the daughter of Former Secretary General and current Head of International Relations, Commissar Godrich Gardee.

In alarming and worrying circumstances, Hillary Gardee, aged 28, went missing on the 29th of April 2022, reportedly on her return from Super Spar Plaza in Nelspruit, Mpumalanga.

Her disappearance has caused untold pain to the Gardee family, and tremendous sadness to all of us as the comrades of Commissar Gardee. Considering the high-levels of violence against women and children in this country, the continued disappearance of Hillary is worrying and leads us all to speculate the worst.

We plead with anyone who knows the whereabouts of Hillary to reach out to the relevant law enforcement agencies and the family, and assist them in finding their beloved daughter.

All ground-forces of the EFF in Mpumalanga must lend a helping hand in the search, to ensure that she is found alive, unharmed and well.
