



EFF STATEMENT ON THE COALITION GOVERNMENTS DIALOGUE

Friday, 04 August 2023

The Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF) will not attend the coalition dialogue organised by government led by Deputy President Paul Mashathile scheduled on 4-5 August 2023 at Jakes Gerwel Hall, University of the Western Cape, Bellville Campus, Cape Town.

In the face of ANC's desperate attempt to facilitate how it should be removed from power, the EFF firmly asserts that the process is not one to be negotiated or presided over by an outgoing and dying ruling party. Our principled position is clear and uncompromising: everywhere the ANC is below 50%, opposition parties must unite to take the ANC out of power. Coalition government frameworks and discussions cannot, and must neither be negotiated nor presided over by those who cling to power while the people suffer.

We recognize the importance of coalition governments as a means to reflect the diverse voices and needs of our society. However, the ANC's involvement in the formulation of this framework exposes a grave lack of impartiality and a blatant attempt to protect their fading grasp on power on the eve of elections.

The EFF emphasizes the importance of an independent and transparent process that is free from the influence of the ruling party, for the development of a framework that truly serves the people of the Republic of South Africa at national, provincial, and local government levels.
