

EFF STATEMENT ON THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOVINEL MOÏSE

The EFF sends its sincere condolences to the people of Haiti, friends, and family of President Jovinel Moïse who was brutally assassinated at his home in Port –Au –Prince in the early hours of Wednesday the 07th of July 2021, an attack which also landed his wife in a critical condition.

As the EFF, we wish to reiterate that the continuous interference of the US and France in the democracies of other countries is wrong and should be rejected with contempt it deserves.

Haiti has known no peace for decades with Presidents changed by foreign agenda of former conquered colonialism including USA on its imperialist policies.

Haiti continues to suffer immensely due to perpetual occupation by US even post the revolution against the French.

The EFF stands with the people of Haiti in the fight for democracy and free and fair elections without the interference of the colonizers.
