The Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF) mourns the passing of one of the longest serving political figures in South Africa and an important leader within the Zulu Royal Family, Prince Mangosuthu Buthelezi.

Prince Mangosuthu Buthelezi was born on the 27th of August 1928 in Mhlalabathini in KwaZulu-Natal, a province where he would go on to make a name for himself as a fierce custodian of Zulu customs and traditions.
