



The EFF SENDS ITS CONDOLENCES ON THE PASSING OF GAUTENG ACTING DIRECTOR-GENERAL THABO MASEBE

The Economic Freedom Fighters sends its deepest condolences on the passing of struggle veteran, activist and committed public servant Thabo Masebe, who passed away tragically on Monday, 18 April 2022.

Masebe was a respected activist, whose invaluable contribution to the war against Apartheid as a youth leader is widely commended and respected. He was part of the fearless generation in the 1980's, which heeded the call from the late Oliver Tambo to render Apartheid South Africa ungovernable, as a young lion.

On the path towards democracy, he led the youth at the highest level, as a Chairperson of the once vibrant Youth League of the ANC in Limpopo, and later as a Treasurer-General of the Youth League in 1994.

Thabo Masebe led from the forefront in the ranks of the youth, and as a result established himself as a brilliant, compassionate communicator since the democratic transition in 1994.

He went on to serve as the Spokesperson for Former President Kgalema Motlanthe, during his tenure as Deputy President, as well as serving as a Spokesperson to former Premier Mbazima Shilowa, before heading communications in the Gauteng Provincial Government.

Due to his commitment to honesty, his respectful approach to the public in the face of grave difficulty, Masebe earned the respect of the South African public. He has communicated on behalf of government in times of great tragedy, in a manner that was considerate and accountable.

The EFF sends its condolences to the family, colleagues and those close to Masebe who have suffered this terrible loss. Masebe must be remembered as a selfless servant, who dedicated his life to the liberation of his people.
