



EFF STATEMENT ON REPORTED BOMBING OF THE HOUSE OF PUDEMO PRESIDENT MLUNGISI MAKHANYA

The Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF) notes with dismay and condemns the bombing of the PUDEMO President Mlungisi Makhanyas' house in eSwatini yesterday.

The family regime of the nonsensical monarch of King Mswati and its cohorts is hellbent on the elimination of pro-democracy activist and the struggle for economic freedom by the people of eSwatini.

The EFF calls on African Heads of States to reign on their illegitimate counterpart and isolate the absolute monarch to force it to desist from such terrorist conduct akin to apartheid government.

The EFF calls on the people of eSwatini to intensify the pressure against the family regime and leave no stone unturned in pursuant of a democratic dispensation by all necessary means including violent overthrow of the despicable archaic fascist monarch.

The EFF shall and will always identify itself with the struggling masses against imperial and colonial aligned regimes throughout Africa unapologetic including practical pragmatic steps to enforce regime change to achieve democratic constitutionalism.

Africa must condemn the slaughter of the more than 200 lives of eSwatini people in the 2021 pro-democracy protest with the contempt it deserves and call upon SADEC Heads of States to stand up against their own who pursue violation of human and people's political rights to freedom to life and association, self-determination and freedom to protest against unjust regime and murderous states.

The EFF will keep an eye on developments in eSwatini and at a right time, will announce drastic rolling mass rolling action by South Africans against the murderous regime of King Mswati. The EFF will further sponsor motion in Parliament condemning the treacherous acts of the feudalist regime of bloodhounds of Mswati and cohorts.

We further call on African States including the South African government to summon the diplomatic representatives of King Mswati to register the anguish and anger of the struggling poverty-stricken people of eSwatini against the harsh realities of brutality and violent conduct of the Mswati regime.
