The EFF has in accordance with the commitment made by the Commander in Chief and President of the EFF Julius Malema, donated R500 000 to the Eschol Community Church in Kwa-Zulu Natal, which houses those affected by the devastating floods.

This comes after an oversight visit to Ward 25 in the Kwa-Mamsuthu area in EThekweni, where the Commander in Chief assessed infrastructure damage and donated 500 blankets and 500 food parcels, to those affected and in need.
