



EFF STATEMENT ON THE DELAYED HANDOVER OF THE FINAL INSTALMENT OF THE STATE CAPTURE COMMISSION REPORT

The Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF) has noted the delayed handover of the final instalment of the State Capture Commission Report.

The report, has ultimately been placed in the hands of the money laundering, kidnapping and bribing Cyril Ramaphosa.

After numerous clandestine meetings, denials of meetings and likely altering of the report, the report has been handed over almost 7-days after it was initially supposed to be.
