Fighter Bella Andronica Malete, was a councillor in the DR JS Moroka Municipality, Fighter Nozulu Matshika, Fighter Lucy Mashamaite and Fighter Johannes Mashsamaite were all EFF members, based in the Nkangala Region in Mpumalanga.

All of them died upon their return from organisational duties.
